IDENTIFICATION OF THE DANGERS

FIRST AID INTERVENTION

FIRE-PROOF MEASURES

HANDLING AND STORE UP

Handling

- o Carefully follow the instructions on the packaging or on the enclosed leaflet/leaflet.

- o Avoid mixing with other or similar products or with different substances not foreseen in the specific instructions.
- o Never put leaked product back into the original containers for further use.
- o Keep products out of the reach of children.

Storage

Store in dry, well-ventilated places (room temperature). Do not store or use the product near open flames or sources of heat or electrical appliances or in direct sunlight. Do not store the product below 5 °C. Close container tightly after use.
